Thank you for booking a footplate / cab experience here at Lappa Valley.

To ensure full compliance with safety regulations, please read the terms, conditions and safety information below.

- Participants must be aged 18 or over at the time of the experience.
- Be in good health (for emergency evacuation you must be fit enough to climb immediately off the locomotive from the ground level unaided. These may be up to a 0.9m (3ft) vertical climb with no steps and on to/ off loose ballast.
- You must be able to cope with discomfort, including head, cold, wet, noise and vibration without distracting the driver. Where doubt exists, we reserve the right to conduct a confirmatory test of fitness prior to the experience.
- Wear sturdy footwear that fully protect your feet.
- Wear clothing that fully protects your legs. (man-made fibre clothing is not acceptable)
- Not attend the experience under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Not to smoke in the cab or on the footplate.
- Be able to communicate clearly in English to immediately acknowledge or comply with any instructions.

We strongly advise you wear older clothing. Lappa Valley cannot be held responsible for any cleaning / damage to clothing.

Our experienced and knowledgeable driver will explain.

- How to safely enter and exit the locomotive.
- Where it is safe for you to sit and what is safe to touch.
- Action in the event of an emergency (including gauge glass failure and emergency exit.

The driver will be happy to explain what is happening during the journey and point out areas of interest, but the footplate can be busy and at times, a noisy place, where the full concentration of the driver is required. It is possible that some questions may have to be answered at the end of the journey where there is a brief period before the locomotive departs again.

Should the directions of the driver not be met, or you act in an inappropriate fashion, you will be asked to leave to the footplate and your experience will be terminated.

You are welcome to bring a camera with you to capture the unique views, but Lappa Valley cannot be held responsible for damage or loss to cameras, phones, or other items.

## Declaration

As a guest riding on the footplate or partaking in a footplate experience course at Lappa Valley, I declare that I am compliant with the conditions listed above and I have undergone a safety briefing with the driver or duty manager, highlighting the risks and key elements of How-to board / alight a locomotive and an overview of the risks associated with a steam / diesel locomotive footplate.

I understand that the locomotive is under the drivers charge and I must comply with any instructions issued to me without question.

I acknowledge that I am riding on the footplate / partaking in a footplate experience course entirely at my own risk and the Lappa Valley Railway Company Limited accepts no liability for damage to personal equipment, loss, injury or death.
